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I like *italicisation* of scientific names, visual methodology, and proper structure. However I noted a few issues:

- The available dataset is only partially capable of addressing the study objectives.
- The study lacks a clearly defined control group, which weakens the experimental design and limits the strength of causal inferences.
- Appropriate inferential statistical analyses were not performed, which weakens the study; therefore, study recommendations are not based on scientific evidence.
- The temporal nature of the data was not adequately analysed, despite measurements being collected over multiple sampling periods.
- Certain study objectives are not fully supported by the available experimental data and rely largely on discussion rather than empirical findings.
- Some observations and measurements that would strengthen comparisons are missing
